



Trimbach 2007 Vintage Report: A Miracle

Much has already been said about 2007, you will understand by reading this one that once again the Alsace micro-climate entirely worked fine and really spoiled us !

Very good weather from April to the 20th of June.

Flowering started early. April and May had higher temperatures than average. Bud breaks around 12th of April !! Flowering started around the 25th of May. Impeccable flowering !

On the 20th of June, severe hail storm. Some growers lost 40% min. up to 100% of their production...

July and August, more difficulties. Cool temperatures and some nice week ends though.

July 14th week end was extremely hot, some grapes got sun burn.

Alsace is France's driest region, still the case in 07.

September and October saw the return of exceptional weather, the proof being that we only had one day of rain in two months !

Very healthy grapes. Easy harvest, no need of table de tries. A miracle !

We started picking on September 10th with Pinot Family (blanc, noir, gris, auxerrois).

Very good natural potential degrees. Pinot Blanc between 11,5° and 12,5°, Riesling, from 11,5° to 13°, etc... Raw material was in super healthy conditions.
